Meet Dr. Jack Mitchell:

Dr. Jack Mitchell was involved in a full time private dental practice for 12 years until God saved him in 1987. From that time until 1996 the focus of Jack's dental career changed to a combination of dental care and spiritual ministry in nursing homes. In 1996, God led the Mitchell's (Jack and his wife Jennifer) to start Grace Dental Mission (now Grace Dental & Medical Missions), a full time ministry partnering with church planting missionaries around the world. Since 1996 the Mitchells have conducted well over a 100 evangelistic dental and medical clinics in 30 different countries as well as on Indian Reservations in Arizona. In addition, they have provided dental care for several hundred individual missionaries. When home, the Mitchells are still involved with twice monthly Bible Studies in a local nursing home. Jack and Jennifer Mitchell have 2 married children, both faithfully serving the Lord through their local churches.
